Dear Parents and Carers of our new Year 7 cohort,

- **Drinks:** Your child should bring a drink or a refillable bottle.
- Lunch: Your child should bring a packed lunch or they can buy food from the College canteen (The Boardwalk). For the second option, please ensure that you have set up your child's Parent Pay account and added money accordingly, a letter will be coming in the post in the coming days explaining how to do this. Please note there will be no option to pay with cash on the day. Those in receipt of free school meals will be catered for.
- **Uniform:** Your child should arrive in full College uniform. PE kit will not be needed on this day. A copy of the updated Uniform Policy is also attached and referred to in Mr. Crawford's letter.
- **Equipment:** Your child should have a full pencil case. Please refer to Mr. Crawford's letter or the Induction Day booklet for the list of required equipment.
- Induction Day Booklet: Please ensure your child brings their completed Induction Day booklet, as it will be needed for their last lesson of the day.

The school day will conclude at 3.05pm, in line with the end of a normal College day. From now on, students will not need a note to walk home.

Additionally, parents will have the opportunity to formally meet their child's tutor after school on Thursday, 12<sup>th</sup> September. More information on how to book an appointment for this Meet the Tutor event will be released in September.
